Terms and Conditions Kraket

- 1. Only members of Studievereniging Kraket have access to member-exclusive functions, such as the exam archive and activities.
- 2. The personal data of members are used exclusively for the membership database of Studievereniging Kraket and the Stichting Landelijk Orgaan der Econometrische Studieverenigingen (LOES). The membership database is used for correspondence from Kraket regarding activities and sponsor mailings. Personal data will not be provided to third parties without the consent of the respective member.
- 3. The Board of Kraket is not liable for any errors in exams, solutions, and/or summaries.
- 4. Payment by bank transfer to the Kraket account for an activity must be completed within five working days after the activity. Otherwise, automatic authorization for direct debit is given. Members can also choose to provide a one-time authorization directly on the website.
- 5. Members hereby declare that they have filled in the information correctly.
- 6. Board members reserve the right to delete a member's profile if they do not comply with the Terms and Conditions. The member will be informed of this.
- 7. The treasurer of Kraket has the right to collect a fine. This fine policy is published under regulations on the website.
- 8. Exams, solutions, and summaries bearing Kraket's watermark are intended for personal use only and may not be distributed on any website other than Kraket's official website. Users of the exam archive are not allowed to modify, reproduce, publish, duplicate, or make available (whether for a fee or not) any part of the archive or exams to third parties.
- 9. If a member disagrees with a debit transaction, they have one month to instruct their bank to reverse the transaction. This must always be reported to the treasurer of Kraket via an email to penningmeester@kraket.nl.
- 10. Photos taken during Kraket activities or in the Kraket room may be published on the Kraket website or used for Kraket promotions. Photos where people are clearly intoxicated or inappropriate, according to the Board, are exceptions. Examples of promotions include publishing photos on Kraket's social media pages, inclusion in Kraket presentations, or use in the newsletter. If a member wishes to be completely exempt, they must submit a Written request to the secretary. Additionally, a member has the right to request the removal of specific photos featuring them from online platforms by submitting a Written request to the secretary.
